## Aggravated Assault Stabbing

### PREVIOUSLY RELEASED INFORMATION:

Approximately 0202Hrs, January 30th patrol officers from Platoon "A" and Selective Enforcement Unit Officers responded to the 911 call for a fight in the area of W. Vine St. and S. Arch St.

Upon arrival Officers located a 32-year-old New Jersey man suffering from multiple stab wounds in a residence in the 1st Blk S. Arch St. Officers called for medical assistance and began speaking to witnesses. The stabbing victim who has ties to the Lancaster area was transported to an area hospital and is listed in stable condition.

Sgt. Gary McCrady located a subject in the 100Blk S. Arch St. that admitted to him that he stabbed someone. This subject was subsequently brought into the police station and interviewed by Detectives.

As a result of this investigation Det. Manuel Luciano charged:

### UPDATED INFORMATION ON ADDITIONAL ARREST:

As the investigation into this stabbing and fight continued throughout the weekend and into the week of February 1st Detective Manuel Luciano also filed charges of Aggravated Assault against the New Jersey man who was stabbed.....

After being released from the hospital, Matos came to the police station on February 4th, where he was interviewed by Det. Luciano regarding the incident and charged, after which he was arraigned by Magisterial District Judge Cheryl Hartman and was released on \$50,000.00 unsecured bail.
