Arrest made in Robbery and Assault

Shortly before 2:00 am, Sunday morning July 4th Officers Tom Cole and David Rachor, as well as other Officers from Patrol Platoon A, responded to Annie Bailey's Irish Pub and Restaurant, located at 28 E. King St, for a report of a subject who had caused a disturbance outside of this location and had threatened security with a knife. Upon Officers arrival, this subject, as well as another person who was with him, fled from Officers, but both were apprehended by Officers after a short foot chase. These subjects were identified as....

Both of the above individuals were identified as the suspects involved in the disturbance and both were arrested and conveyed to the police station. No one was injured as a result of the disturbance outside of the pub. Shortly after this, a Robbery and Assault was reported to Officer Eric McCrady, which had taken place in the 1st Blk N. Prince St, approx. one hour prior to this. The Robbery victim, a 28 year old Lancaster City man, had returned home prior to reporting this Robbery to police.

This victim indicated that he had been walking in the 1st Blk N. Prince St shortly before 1:00 am that morning, was approached by a suspect carrying a crutch and after engaging the victim in conversation, the suspect demanded the victim's I-Pod. When the victim refused this demand, the suspect indicated that his two friends would take it. The victim then walked away and the suspect struck the victim in the back of the head with the crutch that he was carrying, causing a laceration to the victim's head. The victim then fled the area and the suspect was not able to obtain any loot.

It became apparent that these two incidents were connected. Detectives interviewed both of the above individuals and as a result, Luis Garcia-Rivera was charged with Robbery(F-1) and Aggravated Assault(F-1) before Magisterial District Judge Bruce Roth by Det. Lt. Switzer with the respect to the Robbery of the man in the

1st Blk N. Prince St, as well as Simple Assault(M-2) and Disorderly Conduct(M-3) by Off. Tom Cole with respect to the disturbance at Annie Bailey's. He was arraigned on these charges by Magisterial District Judge Brian, bail was set at \$75,000.00 and he was committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of bail. Wilfredo Perez-Rivera Jr received citations for Disorderly Conduct and Underage drinking(both summary offenses) and was released.
