Arrests

1.) THEFT CHARGES

Suspect: Kristy Lynn WOLF 28-year-old female
LKA: 500 block W. King St. Lancaster

Above suspect was arrested on July 16, 2011 on an outstanding theft warrant stemming from an ongoing theft investigation. WOLF is accused of stealing over \$6,000.00 in cash from her employer while she was employed at Captain Gus's Steak Shop, 600 W. Orange St. These thefts occurred between November 5, 2010 – March 26th, 2011. The owner of the business became suspicious after noticing the cash register coming up short on dates that WOLF was working at the business. The owner installed a camera system which captured images of WOLF taking money from the cash register. The business owner then confronted WOLF, who admitted to the owner that she had been stealing money from the register. The business owner audited the register transactions and discovered shortages of \$6,271.00 during the period from 11/5/10 – 3/25/11. WOLF was charged by Off. Michael Landis with one count of Theft by Unlawful Taking (F3) in March of 2011 and a warrant was issued by MDJ Bruce Roth. WOLF was arrested in the 100 blk. Jennings Dr. on the evening of 7/16/11 by the Manheim Township Police and turned over to Lancaster City Police. She was arraigned by MDJ David Miller on July 17, 2011 and released on unsecured bail.

2.) OPEN LEWDNESS

Suspect: Luis Manuel FIGUEROA 29-year-old male
500 block Pershing Ave. Lancaster

At 10:30 a.m., July 12, 2011, a female staff member at San Juan Batista Church, 425 S. Duke St., observed the above suspect standing in the parking lot behind the church. The suspect was watching a group of approximately 13 children, age two to five, who were using a small swimming pool. After watching the children for approximately ten minutes, the suspect reached down his pants and began masturbating. The staff member ran inside the church and alerted another female staff member. Both women came outside and observed the suspect was now laying on the ground under some bushes approximately 40 feet away from the children. The suspect was

still masturbating. One of the women yelled at the suspect, who then fled the parking lot. One of the staff members recognized the suspect from prior contacts through the church.

The suspect was later identified as FIGUEROA via a photo array and FIGUEROA was subsequently charged by Detective Randall Zook with one count of Open Lewdness (M-3) before MDJ Kelly Ballentine. FIGUEROA was arrested on July 15, 2011 and arraigned by MDJ David Miller. He was committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of \$5,000.00 bail.

3.) DUI, FLEEING AND ELUDING, THEFT FROM VEHICLE

Suspect: Alexis ALBINO-SANTIAGO 29-year-old male
500 block S. Lime St. Lancaster

At 4:57 a.m., July 17, 2011, Lancaster City Police officers responded to a report of suspicious activity in the 1200 Fremont St. (A citizen called after she observed someone with flashlight in an alley behind her residence.) Officers walked into the area and observed the above subject exiting a gold Ford Explorer. This subject then entered a Chevy Impala that was parked nearby, and fled the area at a high rate of speed. Off. Eric Pannone and Off. Greg Berry pursued the suspect vehicle onto Fremont St. towards Hershey Ave. The suspect vehicle failed to stop at ten stop signs, and reached speeds of approximately 65 mph in 25 mph zones as it led police on an approximately five minute pursuit through the southwest quadrant of the city. The suspect lost control of the vehicle and crashed into a grass-covered hill on the northeast corner of Prospect St. at Lafayette St. The suspect fled on foot and was captured by the pursuing officers after a brief foot chase. ALBINO-SANTIAGO appeared intoxicated and admitted he had been drinking. Officers observed several car stereos on the front passenger floor of the Chevy Impala. It was later determined that ALBINO-SANTIAGO had broken into the Ford Explorer on Fremont St. and attempted to remove the stereo from that vehicle.

Off. Pannone charged ALBINO-SANTIAGO with DUI, Fleeing or Attempting to Elude Police, Theft from a Motor Vehicle, and (10) counts of Stop Signs and Yield Signs before MDJ Cheryl Hartman. ALBINO-SANTIAGO was arraigned by MDJ David Miller and committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of \$75,000.00 bail. The investigation into the stereos located in the suspect's vehicle is continuing.

4.) BURGLARY

Suspect: Luis Orlando CENTENO-COLLAZO 29-year-old male
1500 block Princess Anne Dr, Lancaster

12:45 a.m., 18 July 2011 Off. Eric Pannone responded to a burglary alarm at Vicki's Place Bar, 701 S. Prince St. Off. Pannone observed the above suspect exiting the front door of the bar. The suspect was holding two bottles of gin, one bottle of merlot, and one bottle of sweet and sour mix. Upon seeing Off. Pannone approach, the suspect began gulping down one of the bottles of gin, and stated, "I'm trying to get f***ed up before I go to jail." It was determined the suspect had entered the bar through a basement window by removing a plywood panel from the window. The value of the loot and damages is estimated at \$60.00.

FIGUEROA was charged with Burglary before MDJ Cheryl Hartman. He was arraigned before MDJ David Miller and committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of \$25,000.00 bail.

information on the location of the suspects. The Safety Coalition advised that the suspects had moved to the 1st block of Locust St. Officers Ryan Work and Anthony Weaver quickly located the suspects and detained them. Both suspects were found to be in possession of handguns. BROWN was in possession of a Taurus .357 Magnum revolver. BROWN does not possess a permit to carry firearms. BROWN was charged with Firearms not to be Carried Without a License before MDJ Kelly Ballentine. He was committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of \$20,000.00 bail.

ACOSTA-CASTILLO had a loaded Taurus PT-25 .25 caliber handgun in his pants pocket. This firearm was reported stolen on February 4, 2011, to the Emmaus Police department. ACOSTA-CASTILLO also had approximately two grams of crack cocaine in his possession. He was charged with Firearms not to be Carried Without a License, Receiving Stolen Property, and Possession With Intent to Deliver Crack Cocaine before MDJ Kelly Ballentine. He was committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of \$40,000.00 bail.

All persons charged with crimes are considered innocent until proven guilty.
