Arrests made in Robbery

Shortly after 2:45 am, early Sunday morning, November 29th, a 35 year old Lancaster City man reported being robbed by multiple suspects in the 200 Blk W. Orange St. During this Robbery, the victim, who was walking in the 200 Blk W. Orange St, was approached by a group of suspects, wearing bandannas over their faces and these suspects subsequently chased the victim down the street, punching and kicking him, as he fell to the ground. During this assault, the victim's wallet and its contents were removed from his pocket and the suspects were seen fleeing the area in a vehicle, parked nearby. An ambulance responded to the scene and the victim was treated for minor injuries.

On Sunday, December 6th as Detectives were involved in an unrelated investigation, it was determined that the following four individuals, who were already in custody, were responsible for committing this Robbery....

As a result of this investigation, Detective James Fatta charged all four suspects with Robbery(F-2) and Criminal Conspiracy(to commit Robbery, F-2) before Magisterial District Judge Bruce Roth and they were held for arraignment.
