Assault

Lancaster City Police are investigating an assault that occurred at approximately 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, December 13th, 2011. The victim, a 30-year-old city woman, was walking in the 300 block of N. Lime St. when she was approached by a passing vehicle, described as:

Vehicle: Green two-door (coupe) passenger vehicle

Driver: White male, approximately 20-30 years old
Light colored hair, clean shaven
Thin build

The driver offered the victim, who is hearing impaired a ride. She accepted the offer and voluntarily entered the vehicle. The vehicle then drove through the city and eventually entered Lancaster Township. At some point during the trip, a physical struggle ensued between the driver and the victim. The victim, fearing for her safety, managed to escape from the moving vehicle in the 200 block of S. Conestoga Dr. The victim walked to a residence in the block and knocked on the door to seek help. The occupants of this residence contacted police and medical personnel. The victim was transported to a local hospital where she was treated and released for minor injuries sustained when she fell from the moving vehicle.
