Burglary Arrest

At approximately 4:47 a.m. on Sunday, October 05, 2008, Officers from the Lancaster Bureau of Police responded to the area of the 100 block of N. Lime Street regarding a burglary in-progress call. Officer Jonathan Reppert observed a male running from the residence from where the burglary was being called in from. A brief foot chase resulted in the arrest of the above subject.

Lugo was found to be bleeding from his arm. Patrol Officers processed the burglary scene and collected evidence. Detectives were called in to interview Lugo, who initially gave a false name.

Lugo was charged with Burglary and False Identification to Law Enforcement Authorities by Detective Heather Halstead before Magisterial District Judge Jimenez.

Lugo was arraigned before Magisterial District Judge Hartmen who set his bail at \$50,000 straight. Lugo was committed to Lancaster County Prison.
