Crime Stoppers-vehicle arson

VEHICLE ARSON

Lancaster City/County Crime Stoppers is offering a reward up to \$1000 for information leading to the arrest and/or conviction of the person(s) responsible for the listed crime.

On Friday, February 25th, 2011, at 5:47 a.m., fire crews were dispatched to the rear of a residence in the 1500 block of Manor Blvd. in Manor Township. The fire department found two burning cars in a rear yard of one of the residences.

An investigation revealed that suspects attempted to steal a 2002 Acura from the Manor Blvd. residence and it became stuck in the backyard. Suspects then stole a 1999 Honda from a residence in the 2100 block of W. Ridge Dr. and drove it to the Manor Blvd. address, attempting to push and pull the Acura from that location. When that failed, suspects set both vehicles on fire, destroying them.
