Criminal Mischief charges-arrest

On the evening of March 17, 2010 at approximately 11:30 p.m., Sergeants Kevin FRY and Jeffrey HAAS were on routine patrol in the Northeast area of Lancaster City. They were advised by the Lancaster Community Safety Coalition (LCSC) staff they they (LCSC) were observing a subject acting suspiciously in the area of the 100 block of East Chestnut Street and the 200 block of North Cherry Street.

Sgts. FRY and HAAS stopped the subject that LCSC had observed in the 300 block of East Marion Street. This person was identified as Darryl Lee HANNA, 44-year-old male. HANNA was found to be in possession of a can of blue spray paint. HANNA was invited to the police station where he was interviewed by Detective Michael Gerace. HANNA was released later that night with no charges being brought.

Detective Gerace began an intensive investigation into numerous acts of Criminal Mischief that had taken place from January 2010 until March 17, 2010. Throughout the course of Det. Gerace's investigation, he was able to determine that HANNA was responsible for at least 23 separate acts of Criminal Mischief and Institutional Vandalism at the following locations:

Criminal Mischief charges-arrest

227 East Orange Street - Estimated damage - \$100.00
240 East Marion Street - Estimated damage - \$114.21
125 East Chestnut Street - Estimated damage - \$265.00
221 North Cherry Street - Estimated damage - \$130.00

Buildings and vehicles at these locations were either spray painted or written on with permanent marker. Various words, symbols and pictures were written and drawn on the buildings and vehicles.

As a result of this investigation, Detective Gerace charged HANNA with Institutional Vandalism (Felony) (5 counts), Criminal Mischief (Misdemeanor-2) (1 count), Criminal Mischief (Misdemeanor-3) (5 counts) and Criminal Mischief (Summary) (12 counts) before Magisterial District Judge JIMENEZ and a warrant was issued. HANNA was arrested today, June 18, 2010 and arraigned on these charges. He was released on \$50,000.00 unsecured bail.
