### Fatal Hit and Run, Update

VICTIM: Omero Garrafa Yanez (H/M/27)  
East Hempfield Resident

VICTIM  
VEHICLE: Mongoose Bicycle

SUSPECT  
VEHICLE: Unknown German Make Hatchback style vehicle

At approximately 0100 hrs. 20 May 10, officers of the Lancaster Bureau of Police responded to the 700 blk. New Holland Ave. for a bicycle Hit and Run Accident . Upon arrival, officers located the victim who was laying on the roadway and was unconscious. The victim was transported to a local hospital for emergency treatment of life-threatening injuries. The victim was admitted to the hospital and later died. The vehicle that struck the man on the bicycle fled the scene.

Several members of the Collision Investigation Team responded to the scene and began the investigation. After interviewing witnesses and collecting evidence which was left at the scene, the suspect vehicle was identified as an unknown German Make Hatchback style vehicle with damage to the front end and undercarriage.
