### Fugitive Arrest

On March 5th the Lancaster City Police received information from a source regarding the below individual, who was to be wanted on several outstanding warrants out of the Philadelphia area, as well as New Jersey....

Shannon Eugene Stanley, 30  
200 Blk E. Madison St.  
Lancaster, Pa.

The information was that this wanted person was also to be posting erotic services on Craig's List under various fictitious names. This investigation was subsequently assigned to Detective Andrew Morgan and after making a variety of contacts, it was confirmed that this individual was wanted in Philadelphia on an outstanding Bench Warrant, Delaware County(PA) for a Parole Violation and out of Cumberland County New Jersey for Wrongful Impersonating/Failure to appear(related to Fraud Offenses). Det. Morgan spoke to Sgt. Fagan and Off. Myers of the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office, confirmed that they did in fact want this individual and that the individual was also in NCC(National Crime Information Center), a national computer data base of wanted individuals, as a wanted person.

It was learned during the course of the investigation, that the wanted individual(Stanley) had relatives that lived at a residence in 200 Blk E. Madison St in Lancaster City and as a result, an undercover investigator made contact with Stanley through the Craig's List posting. Subsequent to this, Stanley directed the undercover investigator to the residence in 200 Blk E. Madison St and at about 2:45 pm, today, the undercover investigator and a contingent of Detectives proceeded to this address to arrest Stanley. The undercover investigator first made contact with Stanley at the front door of the residence, but then Stanley closed and locked the door and would not allow police entry. So as a result, detectives forced entry into the residence through the front door and Stanley was arrested inside. Stanley was subsequently conveyed to the Police Station and held.

As a result of this investigation, Det. Morgan charged Stanley with being a Fugitive From Justice before Magisterial District Judge Janice Jimenez, relative to the New Jersey Warrant. Stanley will be arraigned at a later time and bail will be set and if it is not posted, Stanley will be held at Lancaster County Prison to await extradition back to New Jersey.
