### Indecent Assault

On Sunday, March 18th, 2012, a 15-year-old female city resident was walking through Binn's Park, 100 blk. N. Queen St. at approximately 8:00 P.M. The female was approached by a 25-year-old male, later identified as Ram Chandra SUBEDI, who engaged in conversation with the female and repeatedly offered her money, and asked her to go to a local hotel with him. The female refused and attempted to walk away. Subedi grabbed the female by the arm and continued making similar requests. The female pulled away and continued walking. Subedi then grabbed the female victim from behind, reaching around and grabbing her breast. The victim then ran several blocks to her home and alerted family members and police. Several family members accompanied the victim back to the area of the assault and located Subedi in the 1st block of W. Chestnut St. Subedi fled on foot but was quickly captured and detained by the victim's family members in the area of Penn Square. Police arrived immediately afterwards and separated Subedi from the family members. Police then interviewed the victim, and Subedi was placed under arrest. No one was injured during this incident.

Subedi was transported to the police station and was charged with Indecent Assault, Corruption of Minors, and Unlawful Contact with a Minor by Off. Peter Schmidt before MDJ Bruce Roth. Subedi was arraigned and committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of \$40,000.00 bail.
