Indecent Assaults near McCaskey High School

As a supplement to information previously released by our department, the Lancaster City Police are currently investigating four different instances of Indecent assaults or attempted assaults which have occurred in the vicinity of McCaskey High School, in which a suspect grabbed or attempted to grab teenage girls—Two of them as students were walking to school and one where a student was walking home from an after school activity. The other as the victim was walking home from a friends house later in the evening. The four victims, who were fortunately not injured as a result of these incidents, were all 16 or 17 year old females and all were students at either McCaskey or McCaskey East High School.

The incidents in the morning both took place between 7:30 and 7:45 am, with the first one being in the area of the 800 Blk E. Madison St on Monday January 25th and the other one in the 300 Blk N. Reservoir St this morning. The afternoon incident took place between 4:30 pm and 4:45 pm in the area of 500 Blk E. Frederick St on Tuesday January 26th and the incident in the evening, in the area of 700 Blk N. Franklin St at about 7:15 pm on January 12th.

The suspect in these incidents is described as a light to medium complexion male wearing a black puffy jacket and pajama pants. Anyone with information on these incidents is asked to contact the Lancaster City Police at 735-3300. Callers do not have to give their names to provide information.
