NW Savings Bank Robbery Arrest

INFORMATION PREVIOUSLY RELEASED(on 6 Aug 09):

At approximately 9:40 a.m. on Thursday, 06 August 2009, Officers and Detectives from the Lancaster Bureau of Police responded to a Bank Alarm at 922 Columbia Avenue, Lancaster City (Northwest Savings Bank). The two suspects fled on foot from the bank with an undetermined amount of cash prior to officers' arrival. There were no weapons displayed and no one from the Bank was harmed.

The two suspects were last seen fleeing in a southeast direction from the bank.

SUSPECT 1: Medium to Dark skinned Black male, thin build, 5' 8" to 5' 11"
Late 20's to 30's, Little to no facial hair, short black hair underneath a baseball cap

SUSPECT 2: Medium skinned Black or Hispanic male, stocky build, 5' 5" to 5' 8"
Late 20's to 30's, Full beard neatly trimmed

As a result of the investigation into this Bank Robbery, the below subject was identified as being one of the two suspects involved...

The Lancaster Bureau of Police had been looking for this suspect for several weeks and disseminated information to all Lancaster County Law Enforcement Agencies a few weeks prior to this. It was also determined at this time, that this subject was wanted on several unrelated outstanding summary traffic warrants.

NW Savings Bank Robbery Arrest

Shortly before 1:35 pm today, October 28th, Manheim Township Police Officer Calvin Steidler stopped this subject, in a traffic stop, after he was observed committing a traffic violation in his jurisdiction. Officer Steidler subsequently notified Lancaster Bureau of Police, at which point custody of him was turned over to city police, he was conveyed to the Police Station, and interviewed by Detectives.

As a result of this investigation, Detective Jeffrey Bell charged Osorio with Robbery(F-1) and Criminal Conspiracy(to commit Robbery, F-1) before Magisterial District Judge Cheryl Hartman. Osorio was then arraigned on these charges before Magisterial District Judge Stoltzfus, bail was set at \$100,000.00 straight and he was committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of bail. The investigation is continuing as to the other suspect involved in this Robbery.
