National Drug Control Policy Meeting

Lancaster City Police Chief Keith Sadler was one of a select group of police chiefs invited to attend a roundtable discussion hosted by the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy. This conference, attended by Vice President Joe Biden, Gil Kerlikowske, Director of the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy, Philadelphia Mayor Michael Nutter, and Philadelphia Police Commissioner Charles H. Ramsey, will be held today, October 18, 2011 at 3:30 p.m. at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia, PA.
