Recent Arrests

Drug Arrest - 300 Blk. S. Broad St.

3:10 PM, 29 November 2008: Officers Glenn Stoltzfus and Todd Grager stopped a vehicle in the 300 blk. of S. Broad St. for a speeding violation. This vehicle, a green Lincoln sedan, was being driven by Hiram Lebron-Figueroa H/M/25. A records check through the PA Department of Transportation revealed that Lebron-Figueroa had a suspended driver's license. It was also learned that there were several summary warrants for Lebron-Figueroa through the Lancaster City Police. Lebron-Figueroa was arrested and conveyed to the police station. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle's owner, so the vehicle was impounded and taken to the police station. During a routine inventory search, Off. Shawn Sheckard observed what appeared to be a controlled substance in the back seat of the vehicle. A search warrant was obtained and the vehicle was more thoroughly searched. 644 small packages of heroin were located in the rear passenger area. Lebron-Figueroa was also found to have a large amount of cash in his possession. He was charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver Heroin (F), Driving while Operating Privilege is Suspended and Maximum Speed Limits by Off. Glenn Stoltzfus before MDJ Kelly Ballentine.

Shots Fired / Reckless Endangering – 200 blk. S. Prince St.

1:36 AM, 30 Nov. 2008: Members of the Lancaster Safety Coalition contacted Lancaster County Wide Communications after they observed a subject fire a handgun into the air in the 200 blk. S. Prince St. Safety Coalition employees had been monitoring video cameras in the area when they witnessed this incident. Safety Coalition employees communicated with county dispatchers who guided officers into the area and provided a description of the subject who fired the gun. In less than two minutes, officers located this subject in the block, stopped him and located a .40 caliber handgun in his possession. It was determined that the subject does possess a valid concealed weapons permit.

The subject was charged with Recklessly Endangering Another Person and with violating a Lancaster City Ordinance prohibiting Discharging a Firearm within the city. He was charged before MDJ Cheryl Hartman.
