### Red Rose Run, Street Closings

On Saturday, May 30th, 2009, numerous streets in the city will be closed for the annual Red Rose Run. This event will start at 8:30 AM and conclude at approximately 12:30 PM. The 100 block of N. Queen St. will be closed at 7:00 AM and remain closed until the conclusion of the race. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted in advance along the race route. Vehicles parked on the route the morning of the race may be subject to towing. Streets along the route will begin closing at 8:00 AM. Once the race begins, vehicular traffic will not be permitted on the route. Vehicles will be allowed to cross roadways along the route intermittently. The Lancaster City Police will have numerous personnel assigned to direct and assist traffic during the event.

The race route is as follows:

Start – 100 blk. N. Queen St., north on Queen.  
East on Lemon St.  
South on Duke St.  
West on Chesapeake St.  
South on Rockford Rd. (into Lancaster County Park)  
Through County Park, exit north onto Duke St. from Rockford Rd.  
North on Duke St.  
West on Walnut St.  
South on Queen St.  
Race ends in 100 blk. Queen St.
