Robbery Arrest

On 24 Jun 10 at approximately 0520 hours, Officer Henry Barrie responded to the first block of N. Ann St. where he spoke with a victim of a robbery. The victim stated that a male and female approached him and robbed him of personal items. During the course of the robbery, the victim was punched in the head, then pushed to the ground and kicked by the male that approached him, as well as another male subject. The victim provided a description of the suspects and Off. Barrie broadcasted that description to other police units.

While patrolling the area, Officer Greg Berry located a male and female in the 400 block of E. Grant Street who were subsequently identified by the victim as the subjects that robbed him. Both subjects were arrested and transported to the Lancaster City Police Station.

After interviewing both subjects regarding the robbery, Detectives Phil Berkheiser and Matt Blake enlisted the assistance of the Lancaster Safety Coalition (LSC) in an attempt to identify the third subject in the robbery. The LSC spent several hours reviewing camera footage in the area of the robbery and were able to locate the three subjects on several cameras. LSC turned the footage over to detectives who are attempting to identify the third subject.

As a result of this investigation Detective Phil Berkheiser charged the following:

1. Herbert Daniel MOORE, M/25,
444 Prospect St. Lancaster, PA 17603
Charged with Robbery and Corruption of Minors before DJ Janice Jimenez.
MOORE was committed to the Lancaster County Prison after he failed to post bail.
2. A juvenile allegation for Robbery was filed against an 11 year-old city female. The juvenile was committed to the Youth Intervention Center.
