Serious Motorcycle Collision

VICTIM: Grant LONGER (W/M/30)
East Hempfield Resident

VICTIM
VEHICLE: 1992 Yamaha Motorcycle

SUSPECT
VEHICLE: Unknown white SUV, possibly older model
Damage to the passenger side rear, including a broken taillight

At approximately 1335 hrs. 02 Jan. 10, officers of the Lancaster Bureau of Police responded to the 400 blk. E. Ross St. for a Motorcycle Hit and Run Accident . Upon arrival, officers located the victim who was laying on the roadway and was unconscious. The victim was transported to a local hospital for emergency treatment of life-threatening injuries. The victim was admitted to the hospital and is currently in critical condition. The vehicle that struck the motorcycle fled the scene.

Several members of the Collision Investigation Team responded to the scene and began the investigation. After interviewing witnesses and collecting evidence which was left at the scene, the suspect vehicle was identified as a white SUV style vehicle with damage to the right passenger side area to include a broken taillight.
