### Serious Motorcycle Collision

VICTIM: Grant LONGER (W/M/30)  
East Hempfield Resident

VICTIM  
VEHICLE: 1992 Yamaha Motorcycle

SUSPECT  
VEHICLE: Unknown white SUV, possibly older model  
Damage to the passenger side rear, including a broken taillight

At approximately 1335 hrs. 02 Jan. 10, officers of the Lancaster Bureau of Police responded to the 400 blk. E. Ross St. for a Motorcycle Hit and Run Accident . Upon arrival, officers located the victim who was lying on the roadway and was unconscious. The victim was transported to a local hospital for emergency treatment of life-threatening injuries. The victim was admitted to the hospital and is currently in critical condition. The vehicle that struck the motorcycle fled the scene.

Several members of the Collision Investigation Team responded to the scene and began the investigation. After interviewing witnesses and collecting evidence which was left at the scene, the suspect vehicle was identified as a white SUV style vehicle with damage to the right passenger side area to include a broken taillight.

Officer Adam Flurry is the lead investigator. Anyone with information about the accident or the suspect vehicle is urged to contact Officer Flurry at 735-3300 ext. 3265. Callers can remain anonymous.

## **Serious Motorcycle Collision**

**SUSPECT:** Donald Raymond KING (W/M/59)

Lancaster, PA

**VEHICLE:** 1993 Jeep Grand Cherokee, black in color

King, who is being represented by Attorney Steven Breit, has been fully cooperative with the investigation. Based on the information and evidence obtained from the collision investigation, and statements by King, he has been charged with one count of accidents involving serious bodily injury or death, one count of accidents involving death or personal injury while not properly licensed, and one count of driving while operating privileges suspended. All charges were brought by Off. Adam Flurry before District Justice Janice Jimenez.

The victim in the collision, Grant Longer, has been making great progress in his recovery from the injuries sustained in the collision.
