### Shooting

Shortly before 3:10 pm, Tuesday March 1st, Officers of the Lancaster City Police were dispatched to the 400 Blk N. Franklin St for a report of a shooting that had just taken place there. Shortly after this, Officers were informed that the victim in this shooting was being conveyed to a local hospital in a private vehicle. Officers then proceeded to the hospital, where they were able to locate the shooting victim, the vehicle he arrived in and several witnesses.

The shooting victim, a 24 year old Lancaster City man, was admitted to the hospital suffering from multiple gunshot wounds and he is currently in serious, but stable condition. The witnesses were conveyed to the Police Station where they are currently being interviewed by Detectives.

The investigation conducted thus far has revealed that the shooting took place after an altercation between two groups of people. During this altercation, multiple shots were fired, the victim was struck and everyone fled the scene. The indications are that this shooting was not random in nature, but was a targeted attack and that at least some of the individuals involved were acquainted with each other. Detectives are currently following up on leads and conducting interviews. Anyone with information is asked to call the Lancaster City Police at 735-3301. Callers do not have to give their names to provide information.
