### Shooting Investigation Supplement

#### INFORMATION PREVIOUSLY RELEASED:

At approximately 3:18 a.m. Sunday morning the 19th of July, 2009, Officers from the Lancaster Bureau of Police responded to the address of 245 W. King Street regarding a shooting. It was learned that both the victim and the shooter were inside the private club, The Latin Mix, at this address prior to the shooting. The shooting occurred in the parking lot to the rear of the building.

A 31-year-old Lancaster City Resident was shot one time in the leg and is in stable condition. Members of the Criminal Investigation Division were called in to investigate the shooting. Evidence was collected and witnesses were interviewed.

#### UPDATED INFORMATION ON THE ARREST:

As this investigation continued throughout that week, the following suspect was developed and ultimately identified as the shooter on July 23rd .....

William M. Corporan-Correa, 26  
250 W. King St., Apt. #409  
Lancaster, Pa.

As a result of this, Det. Lt. Clark Bearinger obtained a warrant for Corporan-Correa, charging him with Aggravated Assault(F-1) and Recklessly Endangering Another Person(M-2) before Magisterial District Judge Bruce Roth. In the two weeks subsequent to this, Detectives conducted numerous surveillance details in an attempt to apprehend him. After several hours of surveillance today, August 7th, Det. Lt. Bearinger and Det. Philip Berkheiser, with the assistance of Sgt. Bradley Shenk, as well as Officers Michael Whitaker, Eliud Tirado and Shawn Sheckard, arrested Corporan-Correa at his residence without incident. He was then conveyed to the Police Station, where he was interviewed by Det. Lt. Bearinger and Det. George Bonilla and held for arraignment.

Detectives then conducted a search of Corporan-Correa's residence and located a Taurus .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, believed to have been used in the shooting, as well as other evidence.

Corporan-Correa was then arraigned by Magisterial District Judge Janice Jimenez, bail was set at \$50,000.00 and he was committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of bail.
