### Shooting Suspect Arrested

On 15 June 2011, at approx. 7:01 PM, officers from the Lancaster City Bureau of Police were dispatched to the 1st block of W. Frederick Street for a shooting that just occurred. Officers responded to the scene and located a 19 year old Lancaster man, who was suffering from a gunshot wound to the face. The victim was immediately taken to an area hospital for treatment for non-life threatening injuries.

Detectives responded to the scene and spent the night interviewing witnesses, processing the crime scene and collecting evidence. As a result of the investigation, police were able to determine that the victim went to the 1st block of W. Frederick Street for the purpose of meeting another individual. Police learned that the victim and the suspect were sitting inside the victim's vehicle. Police learned that after a short interaction between the victim and the suspect, the suspect displayed a handgun and fired a shot at the victim, striking him in the face. Police learned that the suspect then fled the scene on foot and was last seen running south on N. Christian Street. The suspect was described as a tall, thin Hispanic male. Detectives have determined that this was not a random act of violence and that the suspect was known to the victim. The investigation is on-going, as Detectives continue pursuing leads in this case. Additional information regarding this investigation will be released as it becomes available.

WANTED SUBJECT – Gabriel SALVADOR-RODRIGUEZ H/M/20

Black hair, approx. 5'8" tall, 145 lbs.

On 16 June 2011, as a result of this investigation, Detective Toby Hickey charged Gabriel SALVADOR-RODRIGUEZ, of Lancaster, with one count of Aggravated Assault and one count of Robbery and obtained a warrant for SALVADOR-RODRIGUEZ' arrest. Police are currently pursuing leads in an attempt to locate SALVADOR-RODRIGUEZ. Investigators have learned that the shooting occurred after the victim met with the suspect for the purpose of purchasing narcotics. At some point during the transaction, SALVADOR-RODRIGUEZ pulled a handgun and attempted to rob the victim. The suspect then fired one shot, striking the victim in the face. Investigators request that anyone with information on the whereabouts of SALVADOR-RODRIGUEZ to contact the Lancaster City Police at 735-3300. Callers are reminded that they do

UPDATE as of 17 June 2011

On 17 June 2011, at approx. 6:30 AM, Gabriel SALVADOR-RODRIGUEZ came into the Lancaster City Police station and turned himself in City Police patrol officers. He was arrested without incident. SALVADOR-RODRIGUEZ will be held for arraignment. Investigators appreciate the assistance provided by the public and the media in assisting with this arrest.
