Weekend Arrests

12:44 AM, 06 Dec. 2008: Officers responded to the area of 16 Garden Court for a report of gunshots. Lancaster County Wide Communications dispatchers relayed information from witnesses that a male subject was seen firing two rounds from a handgun outside of the apartment building, then walking inside 16 Garden Court Apt. #4. Numerous officers responded and surrounded the apartment building. Officers made contact with two occupants inside apartment #4, one of whom matched the description of the shooter. This individual was detained and the apartment was searched. Officers located a loaded black Kel-Tec 9mm semi-automatic pistol inside a kitchen drawer in apartment #4. Officers also located two 9mm shell casings and one live 9mm round on the ground outside in front of the apartment building. The subject identified as the shooter was arrested and conveyed to the police station. During a routine search of the subject during booking procedures, officers located one bag of cocaine in the subject's pants pocket. The below individual was charged with Recklessly Endangering Another Person, Possession of Cocaine, Disorderly Conduct, and Discharge of Firearms by Officer Thomas Cole before Magisterial District Judge Kelly Ballentine:

Charged was: RODRIGUEZ-REYES, Esteban 39 year-old male
Garden Court Apartments
Lancaster, PA

RODRIGUEZ-REYES was arraigned and committed to Lancaster County Prison in lieu of \$15,000.00 bail.

At this time it is unknown if RODRIGUEZ-REYES was firing at a specific target or just randomly fired the weapon. No victims have come forward, and no injured persons were located. The other occupant of the apartment was not charged with any crime.

10:24 PM, 06 December 2008: Off. Jason Zahm observed a vehicle double parked in the 400 block of E. Ross St. Off. Zahm made contact with the occupants and discovered that one of the persons inside the vehicle had an outstanding warrant in Tampa, Florida for Felony Battery by Strangulation (Domestic Violence). This subject was arrested and charged with Arrest Prior to Requisition (Fugitive from Justice) and committed to Lancaster County
