Weekend Incidents

2310 hrs. 12 October 2008 Nicholas Jared BOOS, W/M/23, 436 Black Barren Rd., Peach Bottom, PA was arrested after he left Picasso's Bar, 701 E. Walnut St., Lancaster, and entered a private residence at 701 E. Madison St., Lancaster. BOOS entered the rear of the residence through an unlocked patio door. BOOS took two 40-ounce bottles of beer from the refrigerator, set them on a grill on the back deck, and then re-entered the house. Victim (32 yr-old male) woke up after BOOS turned on the second floor hallway light. Victim told BOOS to leave, and when BOOS refused to do so, victim went downstairs and confronted BOOS. Both became involved in a struggle on the living room floor. Victim's girlfriend called 911 and after forcing open the locked front door, officers found victim physically restraining BOOS on the living room floor. After fighting with officers, BOOS was taken into custody. He kicked Officer Jay Hatfield and later kicked a nurse in the ER of LGH. Neither were seriously injured. Due to BOOS' possible intoxication and/or drug use, he was admitted for observation. BOOS to be charged with Burglary, Theft, Resisting Arrest, Simple Assault, and two counts Aggravated Assault by Off. Henry Barrie. A detainer was issued by probation/parole.

Approx. 2322 Hrs., 11 OCT 08 Officers were dispatched to Picasso's Bar 701 E. Walnut St. for a fight. Upon arrival they located a 42 yr-old male victim with an injury to the back of his head. Victim was transported to LGH and admitted to the Trauma Neuro Unit as a precaution. The victim is in stable condition. Coleman Clary m/22, 46 Spring House Ln. Mountville was identified at the scene as causing the injury. Clary was arrested and transported to the police station and charged by Off. Henry Barrie with Aggravated Assault (F1), Disorderly Conduct (M-3) and Public Drunkenness. Clary posted \$50,000.00 bail and was released the following morning. A second subject believed to be involved in the fight was detained and brought to the police station. No further information at this time regarding the second subject.

1013 hrs 12 Oct. 2008 Officers responded to the area of Linear Park (300 blk. W, James St.) for a report of indecent exposure A 19 yr-old female was walking to the CVS store on Prince/Lemon from the area of 300 W. James St. She noticed a man following her and talking to her to get her attention. Victim entered Linear Park and Suspect exposed himself to her. She fled and he followed her until she screamed. Suspect then fled back toward James St. Suspect described as: b/m/mid 20's med-dark complex. 5'-10"-5'-11" 160 pounds wearing black oversized t-shirt and jeans slight facial hair and goatee. Officers checked area but the suspect was not located. Notice to LCSC made for surveillance camera review. Investigation continuing.

1954 hrs./ 12 October '08 an unknown B/M/20-25 yoa wearing a full faced ski mask and brandishing an unknown dark-colored type pistol entered Latin Grocery @ 601 S. Prince St. Once inside the suspect pointed the

pistol at the victim and demanded he open the cash registrar. Once the registrar was open the suspect removed the cash tray and took an unknown amount of cash and a carton of cigarettes prior to leaving. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate the suspect. The victim was not injured.

12 Oct. 2008 Officers conducted an enforcement detail at Longs Park in response to numerous citizen complaints of subjects engaging in lewd behavior in the park. During the am hours Sunday, 12 October 08, officers made the following arrests:
